Attendance Policy

SCHOOL START DATE FOR STUDENTS: AUGUST 10TH, 2022 (Wednesday)

Students shall be counted in attendance if they are actually present at school at the time the attendance is taken or are away from school on a school day and engaged in an educational activity that constitutes a part of the school approved instructional program for the student (Section 1003.23, Florida Statutes). As per the School Board Policy 4.16, after nine absences in a course, credit may be withheld. The Child Study Team will develop a contract with the student and parents that includes a plan to restore the credit withheld.

All students are expected to be on time and present each day school is open during the school year. Excessive absences also will result in driver's licenses being revoked from the State. Please review our full attendance policy information on our school website. You may reach out to the Attendance Office or School Social Worker for attendance questions.










Student Parking

For all student drivers, parking decals can be purchased at Open House scheduled for August 8th at 6:00 p.m. Mrs. Rodriguez will also sell decals in Student Services between 9:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. beginning July 26th. Students must have a parking decal to park on campus.

The cost for each decal is **\$40.00**. The parking decals can be purchased through MySchoolBucks.com. Once you have purchased the decal, the account purchase on MySchoolBucks.com will be marked pending until the signed paperwork is returned to Mrs. Rodriguez in Student Services.



If your student is planning to attend college, seniors should sign up and begin taking these tests as soon as possible. Juniors should take the tests in the second semester to determine which test they feel most comfortable with and scored better on. They can then focus on that test for the remainder of the time until they submit their college applications.

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
