10\19\2020

Mrs. Roles opened the SAC meeting at 6:30 p.m. and greeted the attendees. She then began introductions of the Administration for the 2020-2021 school year.

2. Mrs. Turner - Assistant Principal, Curriculum Specialist, Math Department, and previously Math and Special Ed. teacher
3. Mr. Kurtz - Assistant Principal for 13 years, In charge of The Center of the Arts, Building grounds, and involved in P.E. and JROTC, Covers Students A-F
4. Mr. Cole - Assistant Principal with 1 year at CLHS, In charge of Safety & Security, Teaches 1 Business Class
5. Mrs. Bond - Assistant Principal with 4 years at CLHS in various positions, Covers Students O-Z
6. Mrs. Robinson - Testing Coordinator (FSA, SAT, AP), Took over Mrs. Bond's position this year, In her 4th year at CLHS, Senior Sponsor, In her 10th year of teaching, Teaches 1 Senior English Class

Mrs. Roles then announced that Student Services personnel will come to our next meeting.

District Wins:

1. The Superintendent, Dr. Adkins, visited CLHS on the first day of the 2020-21 school year.
2. Technology - Art on the computer has been introduced in the Center of the Arts. CTE - Industry Certification available
3. CLHS roof is being replaced on all campus buildings.
4. ARTS Department activities was presented on ABC-7 animation program
5. A TAG video was created and presented on Zoom. Mrs. Cosbey said her daughter was a contributing student on the zoom presentation. She noted that each student filmed themselves at home, submitted their video, and then all videos were edited together for the final presentation. Mrs. Roles bragged about the quality of the presentation and thanked Mrs. Cosbey for sharing the personal information about her daughter and how the video came together.
6. Mrs. Turner expressed thanks for all who have shared pictures of classrooms in the building showing activities being done.
7. Mrs. Burnham's Dance class is celebrating their first year developing a family tree including the students on Lee Home Connect.

Mrs. Turner then presented statistics concerning the summer survey to parents whose children might want to change their form of schooling in the 2nd quarter. She said there were 210 students who have chosen to return to the face-to-face model. And there are 7 students switching to Lee Home Connect. Mrs. Turner will be evaluating whether lunch schedules will work on the present schedule. She will also be looking at class sizes and the possible need to move students around. The District also lifted the rule about Lee Virtual attendance. They stated that students who started the year in Lee Virtual will be allowed to switch at the beginning of quarter 2 instead of waiting until the end of the semester.
